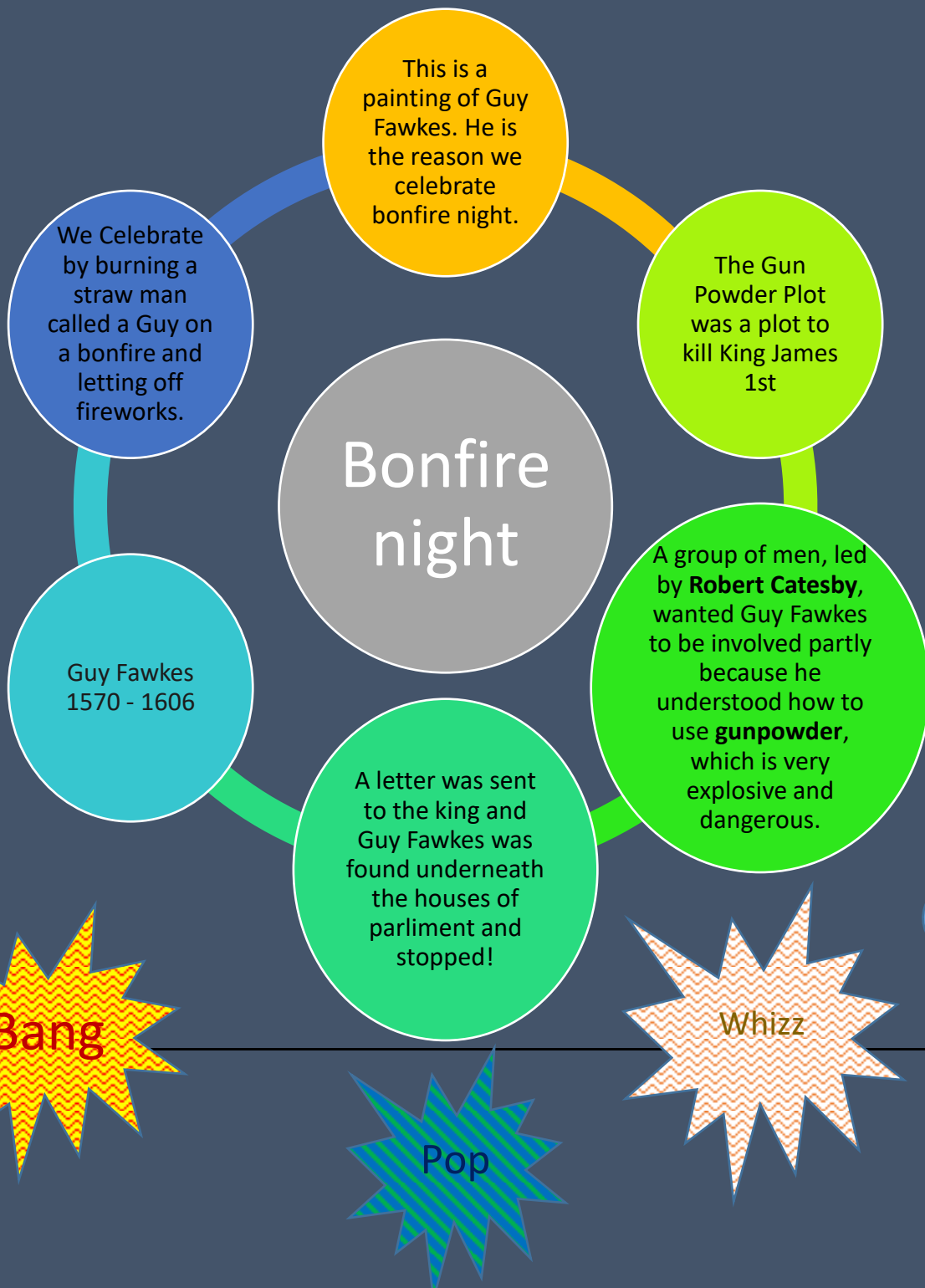
Some festivals or events use light to help us celebrate or remind us of something!

A Menorah is a special type of candle holder. It is lit by Jewish people. One candle is lit for each day of the festival.

Hanukkah celebrates one of the greatest miracles in Jewish history.

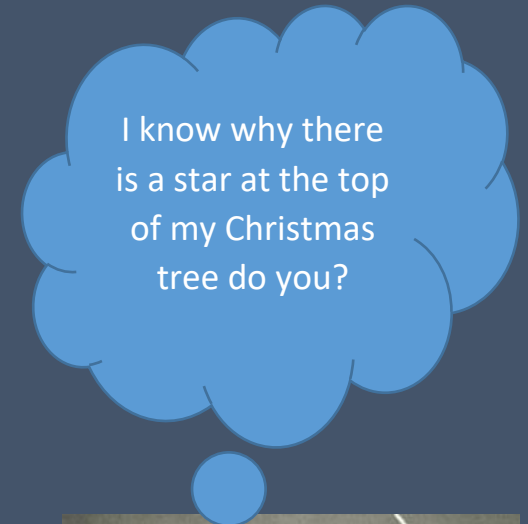


