Head Teacher Update

I have tried to take a common sense approach this week and I thank you again for your support in providing children with hats and sun cream during this particularly hot period. It always concerns me slightly when this country experiences these more extreme temperatures as we are not used to it and the school building was certainly not designed for the hot climate.

I have asked all the staff to also use the common sense approach and to not keep children out for any length of time including the lunch break. We are lucky that we have plenty of shade but some of our dedicated footballers also think that they can play in the same way as the cooler months so we have restricted this for their own health.

I have had to give some of our younger children a reminder that their private parts are private and that they should not be showing them to other people. We have used the NSPCC PANTS materials to help us get this message across but I would also be grateful if you could also reinforce this message at home.
