Dear Parents/Carers,

In this ever changing world in which we are living there are many challenges. As a school we are at the heart of the community and want to support our children and families as best we can. It is really important that we ensure that you have everything that you are entitled to as parents and in particular if you attract additional funding to support your child as a result of your family circumstances.

I don't want any child to be disadvantaged in their learning as a result of financial constraints. We receive a grant from the Government that is called a Pupil Premium grant and this is used to support children and families from lower incomes and also if they are under the care of the Local Authority or ever have been. This grant is also for children who have parents in the Armed Forces.

I want to be sure that if you do think that you may well be entitled for additional support for your children we will be able to provided additional support in school to improve learning and also opportunities for funded after school clubs or music tuition.

To be eligible, you must be receiving one or more of the following benefits:

- Income support.
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance.
- Income-based Employment and Support Allowance.
- Support as a result of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- Pension Credit.
- Child Tax Credit.
- Working Tax Credit.

We would also need evidence of Post Looked After children and Service children in order to comply with auditing procedures.
