

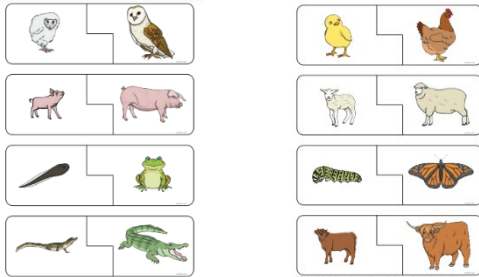


Castles and Kingdoms – Summer 1 – Year 2 – Knowledge Organiser
