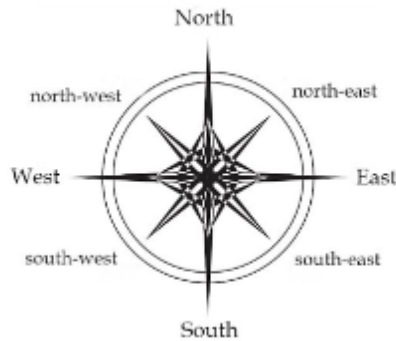


Pesky Pirates Year 2 – Knowledge Organiser

Pirates

Harry Paye

1360 - 1419

1. Harry Paye was a Pirate and Smuggler from Poole.
2. He intercepted hundreds of ships off the Dorset coast.
3. He stole from the rich and gave to the poor.
4. He brought back their precious cargo: wine, gold exotic food to share with the people of Poole. They saw him as a hero!



Edward Teach - Blackbeard

1680-1718

An English pirate who sailed around the West Indies and North America. He became a renowned pirate. He got his nickname because of his thick black beard. Edward Teach lived in Bristol.

Alfred Wallis

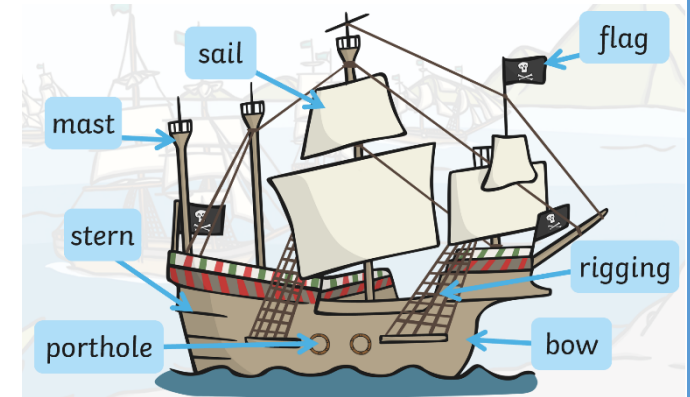
1. Alfred Wallis was a painter who was known for his port landscapes and shipping scenes

Life of a Pirate Parts of a pirate ship



<u>Vocabulary</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Pirate	A pirate is a sailor who attacks other ships at sea and steals their property.
Piracy	Piracy is an act of attacking and robbing ships at sea.
Cutlass	A short sword with a slightly curved blade used by pirates.
Booty	Treasure (like money or jewels) stolen by pirates.
Sloop	A type of ship that moved very quickly and easily. It was perfect for chasing another ship to steal from them.
Rigger	A big and heavy ship. It carried lots of loot, up to 20 cannons and 200 men.
Properties	This is what a material is like and how it behaves.
Transparent	Something you can see through.
Opaque	Something you can't see through.
