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Head Teacher Update

It has been a great week in school again this week. The children have been really focused on their learning and I have been in classes most days as well as during lunchtimes. We are trying to ensure that table manners are developed and that food goes into mouths rather than on the floor. We are working with the children on using the cutlery to cut their food and for them to sit up properly at the tables.

We held another Parent Learning Evening for our Reception parents yesterday, although sadly, I was not able to make this one on this occasion. Thank you to those of you who were able to attend. We hope you found the evening useful. We will put all of the slides and resources from the evenings on our website for you to look at it if you would like to.

Our Reception children had a visit from the Police this week as part of their learning about people who help us. They certainly enjoyed the visit and thank you to PC Beth who came in to talk to the children. It was slightly disconcerting when I heard sirens in the playground though!

Thank you to everyone who has signed up for Parent Consultations. If you haven't then there is still time and we will look forward to meeting with you. We do now have a number of lettings in the evenings as we try to supplement already stretched budget to get the 'nice to have' things for the school. We will try to ensure that there is clear signage to different parts of the school, but the hall will be out of bounds for obvious reasons. Thank you for your understanding.

You may have noticed a couple of changes happening around the school. The buildings in the Key Stage 1 playground are having a bit of a makeover to ensure they are watertight and that resources can be stored in them without getting damaged, primarily for POPS resources. We then aim to refresh the mural on the wall that has been there for about 12 years now and is in need of an update. The slight issue is the cost of doing that from different firms, so I am looking for a slightly cheaper option. If you know of any great artists who would be interested in a project like this, I would be very grateful.

We had one of our Bikeability sessions this week for our Key Stage 2 children on the playground after school. This is again an essential skill for children and one that we need to try and make sure the skills learned are transferred to the roads and then sustained as the children get older and leave the school for their own safety. Some of the riding of the older children has been very dangerous lately.

You may also have noticed that a new sign has been erected as you approach the school, before the shops. This will be another speed reminder for traffic outside the school. I am hoping the new signage will be approved and installed soon to stop parking outside of the school gates to improve safety for you all. Please can I remind everyone that scooters/bikes should NOT be ridden on the playgrounds at any time including picking up from clubs. Also, dogs are not permitted on site unless they are working in the school with the children. Thank you very much.

I am now looking forward to a weekend of rugby after a VERY busy week.
