Head Teacher Update

Welcome back! I hope that you have all had a very enjoyable Christmas break. It was certainly a shock to the system on Tuesday arriving at school in the darkness and the rain pouring down. The children have returned exceptionally well again after the holidays. We will continue to share what the children are learning with you again this term so that hopefully you can also support this at home in conversations.

I know that I sound like a broken record but it is very important that children remember key knowledge and experiences. We are going to continue to provide opportunities for children to have different experiences and learning opportunities. We have another live show planned this term in addition to a number of other visits and visitors coming in to the school.

We have started the year with an assembly this week where we have spoken to the children about what is expected of them in school and to try and make sure that they know who they need to speak to if they are worried about anything. Another area we will continue to teach the children about is Internet Safety. I am sure many children had electronic devices for Christmas and games that they had to play connected to these. It is essential that children remain safe online. In school, we have a filtering system that is tested on a monthly basis to ensure that no harmful content is accessible. Obviously we can't do that in every home so we want to make sure that children are also knowledgeable about how to keep themselves safe. On a completely different note, we are continuing to develop the grounds for the children. We had to put our Forest School on pause sadly for a short period of time due to a lack of funding but we have managed to find a solution so are planning for the future. We have been able to get resources from a charity and also some new trees that will be planted withing the grounds. It is something I am really keen to try and get children learning in classrooms without walls (outside). We have the grounds to do it now and once all the Health and Safety requirements are in place we can proceed.

It is also really important that children are in school. Attendance is a key educational topic and we want to ensure our children are in school. We obviously understand that sometimes children are unwell and that can't be helped. Holidays will not be authorised in term time and we have a responsibility to report these to the Local Authority who will decide to issue penalty notices for these term time holidays. Please can you also ensure that children arrive on time as we do start the day promptly and the learning begins as soon as the children enter the school. Again, we appreciate that there are traffic issues on rare occasions and the unexpected. If you are late, please use the Sign In app to record the reason for lateness for our records. Thank you very much for all of your support with this. We want to work with you as families to support you as much as we can.
