



Home School Partnership Agreement

1. **The school will**

- contact parents if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality or equipment;
- let parents know about any concerns or problems that affect their child's work or behaviour;
- send home an annual report;
- provide home learning relevant to the age and needs of the child;
- arrange for opportunities to meet teachers regularly during which learning and progress will be discussed;
- keep parents informed about school activities through regular letters home via email, texting, Marvellous Me and updating the school website;
- listen to and discuss parents' concerns.

2. **The Parents - I/We shall try to:**

- see that my child goes to school regularly, on time and properly equipped;
- let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect my child's learning or behaviour;
- support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour and uniform;
- support my child in home/remote learning tasks and other opportunities for home/remote learning;
- attend parents' evening and discussions about my child's progress;
- get to know about my child's life at the school.

- 1 Please visit the school website for information and advice concerning purchasing of uniform and other general procedures. If you have further queries, then the office staff will be able to offer support.
- 2 The class teacher is the first point of contact for all concerns regarding your child.
- 3 The Deputy Headteacher or other key stage staff can then be approached for help and advice.
- 4 The Headteacher, will meet with parents either by appointment or, in an emergency, at short notice. Please contact the office for an appointment.
- 5 For any concerns regarding any Special Educational Needs, please contact our SENDCo.
- 6 Governors can be contacted through the Clerk of Governors and through parent governors.
