## HEADTEACHER UPDATE

I hope you have all had a good week. It has been a busy one again and a little disrupted yet again by the weather, either raining during lunchtimes leading to a mass evacuation of the playgrounds or usually at pick up or drop off. Unfortunately it did cause some damage in school as an internal drain pipe (which is 60 plus years old) came away from the roof. The only problem with that was that it was in our stationary cupboard which is literally the worst place for it to happen as it is where we store all of our books. I got a soaking but we saved most of them!

We have had a very busy week in school with a significant number of quizzes taking place across different year groups. The children always tend to enjoy these. Many of them really do like a quiz! They provide us with useful, standardised information to help us compare how our pupils are performing against others nationally.

Alongside our in school assessments, we are also completing the statutory assessments at this time of year. These include phonic assessment and Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) outcomes. Once these have been finalised and nationally validated, the results will be shared with you in your child's end of term report.

I want to take a moment to say how incredibly proud I am of our children. They have worked exceptionally hard this year, and we are confident that our outcomes will once again be above national expectations. Their positive attitudes, resilience and enthusiasm for learning continue to shine through.

You may also be aware that our Year 4 pupils have taken part in the National Multiplication Tables Check. The results for this are not released to schools immediately and, even when they are, we do not receive detailed individual data in the same way as with other assessments. However, it remains a valuable experience for the children and helps to support the development of their fluency in Maths.

We are also currently beginning to write our School Development Plan for the next academic year. This is an important piece of work that helps to shape our priorities and ensure continued improvement across the school. A significant focus within this plan will be on attendance. It is vital that all children attend school regularly so that they can fully benefit from our curriculum, and we will be working closely with families to ensure that attendance for all pupils is well above 96%.

It will be back to normal next week in terms of learning about the different aspects of the curriculum.
